Which species can we offer ?





Over one hundred species are available in our Ali Baba's cave ! We have attempted to present them in a convivial manner, starting with the lightest and ending with the darkest. If you are looking for a particular specie, you will find it in the alphabetic index at the back of the brochure which will direct you to the appropriate page. Burr and curl are listed separately. Those species available in crown or quarter cut are marked respectively with a little © or @ .

Most of the species presented here are available from stock at our warehouse (we keep in stock almost 2 million m² of veneers !) but some, more fragile ones, do not stand extended storage. We therefore prefer to purchase and select them at the right moment according to the precise wishes of our customers. The former are marked with a little green tree [🌳], the latter with an orange one [🍂].

Twenty or so species are available from stock in Masterflex® : these are shown by a little logo in the top right hand corner [].

Finally, if you wish to dream while leafing through this range, let your imagination run free, but don't forget that all dreams have a price : before falling in love with a species that is unfamiliar to you, cast an eye on the little green bank notes in the bottom right hand corner, which will give you some idea of the price of one specie relative to another. One last word of advice : the species that you are about to discover in the following pages are nothing more than indicative samples. They must not, under any circumstances, be considered as a reference against which to compare the panels received. Forewarned is forearmed, as they say...
